



LOCAL Pickup Truck Pull-off Rules for Stock and Altered Gas and Diesel 2-Wheel & 4-Wheel

ALL Entrants:

(Truck Class Exceptions are on page 2)

1. All trucks and drivers must be a resident of McLean County.
2. Trucks cannot be towed on a trailer to Truck Pull.
3. Owners must drive their truck. Owners must present a current insurance card, vehicle registration, and valid driver's license to register. The license and VIN must match the truck.
4. Truck can only pull in one class; unless time allows more.
5. Truck inspections, before or after your pull, that find violations to the following rules of their Pull Class will result in an immediate disqualification of truck and driver; all registration fees will be forfeited; and all prize money will be forfeited. Inspectors will take steps to check for modifications.
6. All trucks must burn only Gasoline or Diesel fuel. No fuel additives allowed. This includes (but not limited to) nitrous, alcohol, and LP.
7. Trucks can have 6, 8, or 10 cylinder gas or diesel motors.
8. Trucks must be factory weight – no added weights allowed.
9. All trucks must have stock wheel base.
10. Trucks tires must be DOT approved and street legal. No cut tires. Maximum tire size is 31 inches. Pickups with dual wheels must remove the outside set of tires.
11. Must have spring suspension boxes and springs must be in place. No ladder bars. No suspension modifications. No suspension locking devices will be allowed.
12. Exhaust must extend behind cab.
13. Hitch height will be 22 inches and have an opening of 3 inches.
14. Beds must be empty of loose items. Fuel tanks or tool boxes must be removed.
15. Engines must be in stock location, in stock motor mounts.
16. First truck out in each class can decline the distance and come back 3rd.
17. Puller will have 2 chances to get past 75 feet marker.
18. After starting a pull, no shifting is allowed.
19. Track judge's decision is final.
20. No alcoholic beverages allowed on the property.
21. ITPA Rules will be enforced.

All Trucks must adhere to the rules listed on page 1, unless, a specific Class Rule (listed below) explicitly states a difference from the rules on page 1.

Stock Gas Class:

(Modification to trucks will NOT be allowed. This includes (but not limited to) the OEM motor, exhaust, carburetion system, suspension, or frame.)

1. Must pull 19 inch vacuum at 800 RPM

Altered Stock Gas:

1. Can have ladder bars, dual carburetors, headers, aluminum intakes

Diesel Stock:

1. Stock factory turbo only.
2. No performance parts

Altered Diesel Class:

1. Can have Power chips, traction and ladder bars

Registration:

- Hook Fee: \$20 if postmarked by July 22. \$30 on all registrations after July 23
- 80% pay back per class.
- Pre-registration forms can be acquired by contacting Jon Wey, 309-473-3050, or 309-275-3843, or the McLean County Fair, 309-663-6497.
- Registration table on event night (July 29) will be open from 3:00pm until 5:45pm. No registrations will be allowed after 5:45pm.
- Each paid entry receives 4 admission armbands to pit area.
- All other pit passes cost \$15.
